

RESUMPTION OF FLIGHTS GUIDELINES (as of 01 March 2021)

Who may travel:

1. Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) – returning or repatriated OFWs and other OFs
2. Locally stranded individuals (LSIs)
 - a. *Foreign nationals or Filipino citizens in a specific locality within the Philippines who have expressed intention to return to their place of residence / home origin."*
 - b. *LSIs can be further classified to "workers, students, tourists, or other individuals stranded in various localities while in transit".*
3. Authorized persons outside residence (IATF Resolution No. 79)
 - a. Health and emergency frontline services personnel
 - b. Government officials and government frontline personnel
 - c. Duly authorized humanitarian assistance actors (HIAAs)
 - d. Persons traveling for medical or humanitarian reasons
 - e. Persons going to the airport for travel abroad
 - f. Anyone crossing the zones for permitted work or business permitted in the zone of destination, and going back home
 - g. **OFWs and other OFs returning to their place of residences**
 - h. Other persons transported through the efforts of the national government upon concurrence of LGUs.

Documentary Requirements to Travel

- **Mandatory:** Required at check-in before passenger acceptance (per DILG MC 2020-087 for ROF & LSI)
- **Recommended:** Not required for passenger acceptance but may be required by destination LGU to allow entry (it is recommended for passengers to double-check requirements with destination LGU).

MANDATORY

Note:

- All passengers on any mode of public transportation must wear face shields, aside from face masks, starting August 15, 2020, as mandated by Department of Transportation. (DOTr)
- **All passengers will no longer be required to undergo COVID-19 testing except if the Local Government Unit (LGU) of destination shall require testing prior to travel.**
- **Testing for COVID-19 will be limited to RT-PCR tests.**
- **Passengers will no longer have to undergo quarantine unless an individual shows symptom upon arrival at the LGU of destination.**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS PER LGU

ANTIQUE

LSIs and APOR

- LSI coming from areas outside Region VI coming into the Province of Antique shall have:
 - **Letter of Acceptance** or **Notice of Coordination** from the receiving municipal local government unit
 - LSI coming into Province of Antique via Iloilo International Airport, Iloilo Port, or Dumangas Port, except Caticlan Port and Kalibo International Airport shall no longer be fetched by their respective municipal local government units. However, their arrival shall be coordinated with the Municipal Health Office of their municipality.

REMINDER: Provide a copy of flight manifest to Antique Inter-Agency Task Force on COVID-19 (Isirepatteam@gmail.com) every flight TO/FROM Antique.

BACOLOD

Blacklisted from entering Negros Occidental for violation of RA 11332, the following employees of PAX CABLE, INC. pose risk to the health and safety of people in the Province of Negros Occidental:

Operational Requirements

- The passenger manifest shall contain the contact numbers and final destination of all persons issued tickets for travel and shall be submitted at no later than 12:00 noon of the day before the intended date of travel.
- GOSHO or walk-in passengers are allowed provided that they have Valid ID with address in Negros Occidental.
- Issuance of tickets for MNL-BCD flights will be allowed provided that all returning passengers are Negrenses.
- Government issued ID **must** be presented as proof that they are from Negros Occidental

- **RT-PCR Test upon arrival in Manila and must be quarantined until negative result is released**
- Upon arrival in Bacolod City, documents will be checked and verified by Action Team on Returning OFWs (ATRO)
- BaCTrac Registration
- Health Declaration Form
- All concerns of OFWs and ROFs must be coordinated with the office of SPM Israel Salanga

APOR

- Identification Card
- Travel Order
- Travel Itinerary
- Must pass symptom-screening at ports of entry and exit

- **Negative Result of RT-PCR test taken with 3 days before the date of travel**
- Travel Itinerary for the duration of stay in Bacolod City at for the first ten (10) days, whichever is shorter
- Confirmed Booking of Accommodation in Bacolod City
- Roundtrip ticket/travel details
- BaCTrac Registration
- Health Declaration Card

RETURNING RESIDENTS ARRIVING FROM COUNTRIES WITH TRAVEL RESTRICTION DUE TO NEW COVID-19 STRAINS BASED ON THE NAITF LIST

- **Negative Result of RT-PCR test taken with 3 days before the date of travel**
- BaCTrac Identification Card
- Online Health Declaration Form

NON APOR

A. ALL NON-APOR TRAVELING TO THE PROVINCE OF NEGROS OCCIDENTAL

- All returning Non-APOR will be swabbed

- LGU may facilitate transportation if private shuttle/vehicle is not available

Note:

- **There shall be an established Environmental, Tourism and Development Fee (ETD Fee) of **Php 200.00** to be collected at Tourist Information Centers from Coron Airport that shall be levied from all the tourist/visitors that shall visit the municipality.**

- Confirmed Tour Booking with Licensed Tour Operators
- Roundtrip ticket
- Health Declaration and QR Code Registration at www.corontourism.ph

Note: All arriving tourists will undergo a health assessment upon arrival at Busuanga Airport. If they are found to be symptomatic, they will undergo mandatory antigen tests. Tourists who also have been in contact with an active positive case will also be subjected to mandatory testing. The tourist will shoulder the Php3,500 fee. If tested positive for COVID-19, the tourist/s will be brought to the hotel isolation room where he/she is booked while waiting for the results. Tourists are responsible for any medical/accommodation bills related to COVID-19.

Coron / Busuanga / Linapacan

LSI / ROF / APOR

- RT-PCR Negative Test Result (24 to 72 hours validity) with a corresponding Official Receipt from any DOH accredited testing facility to be presented upon check-in and LGU personnel upon arrival
 - Negative Saliva RT-PCR Test Result (taken within 72 hours) conducted by the Philippine Red Cross will also be accepted for passengers bound to Municipality of Coron
- Certificate of Acceptance by the receiving LGU (EOC Busuanga)
- Health Declaration and QR Code Registration at www.corontourism.ph
- Any person manifesting symptoms of COVID-19 during his stay in the municipality shall be quarantined and tested using RT-PCR. If the test result is positive the person shall be isolated for twenty-one days (21) and will be the one to shoulder all pertinent expenses to be incurred relative to his quarantine in a hotel establishment as pre-determined by EOC-Coron.

- Presentation of other Certification as agreed by the Agencies (for finalization)
- Must be tested negative at point of origin
- Negative test result must be presented and must not be older than five (5) days prior to their travel date
 - Test result to be presented must be a negative RT-PCR test by all passengers to and from BXU

REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSIT AT BUTUAN AIRPORT

- Negative RT-PCR test which shall not be older than five (5) days prior the travel date
- Certificate of non-issuance of Travel Order

NOTE: If a passenger cannot present item (2) and (3) as there are LGUs and other competent agencies from their point of origin that no longer issue above documents, the same may be allowed to board subject to the CAAP and Airline concerned approval or item (4) may suffice.

CATICLAN

Note: Effective 01 October, Boracay Island may accept tourists from areas under GCQ and MGCQ except those in Western Visayas.

General Requirements:

- Persons with comorbidities shall not be allowed to enter Boracay Island
- Port of entry of tourists to Boracay Island will only be MPH.
- LSIs, ROFs, and APORs travelling by air shall only go through KLO.

NON-AKLANONS

Tourist Requirements:

- Negative RT-PCR test result (72 hours validity) – all tourist except children aged two (2) years and below
- Confirmed booking from DOT-accredited establishments
- Register online as tourist for the Health Declaration Card with QR code available on: aklan.gov.ph or touristboracay.com. The QR code is a mandatory pre-boarding requirement. **NO QR CODE, NO ACCEPTANCE**
 - *REMINDER: The Tourist QR Code has an expiry of twelve (12) hours from the checkout time. If pax is extending their stay in Boracay Island, they should send an email of a new booking slip showing the extension to touristboracay@gmail.com before their original checkout time.*

- ***For tourist travelling by air, only Caticlan Airport in Caticlan shall be the port of entry and exit to Boracay, thus KALIBO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT shall only cater to Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROF), Locally Stranded Individuals (LSI), Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR) and other emergency travellers.***

CEBU PROVINCE

TOURIST

- Valid Medical Certificate (issued by a reputable doctor and within seven (7) days prior to travel date)
- Proof of Pre-booking at a resort or hotel establishment where pax will stay during the duration of visit. The resort or hotel establishment should be located within the Province of Cebu and duly accredited by the Cebu Provincial Task Force
- Pass symptoms checking or screening at the point of departure and point of arrival

LSI

- Valid ID

APOR

- Valid ID from respective government agency
- Original or certified true copy of a travel authority or order issued by the Department of Secretary or his designated official
- Medical Certificate (Private APOR)

NOTES:

- Persons with incomplete documents shall not be allowed to board the aircraft
- All passengers and personnel should wear face shields and face masks when accessing Mactan-Cebu International Airport Terminal premises and during their flight effective August 15, 2020. Face shield should sufficiently cover nose and mouth.

CEBU CITY

 - Saliva and Antigen test is subject for approval from Cebu City Mayor's Office

NOTES:

Exemptions from the Letter of Coordination and Quarantine / PCR Swab Test Requirements:

- Transiting pax in Manila provided they will show proof of port of origin (e.g. boarding pass, ticket)
- Originating pax from Cebu City who are classified as APOR (Cebu City based worker/employer who will have a short visit to Manila)
- Passengers under the classification above who cannot provide Letter of Coordination will be accepted upon check-in but will need to coordinate / call their barangays before boarding
- Upon arrival in Mactan Cebu Airport, passengers without Letter of Coordination will need to approach the kiosk of the Cebu City LGU for validation and confirmation of acceptance.

LAPU-LAPU CITY

Effective January 4, 2021 Lapu-Lapu City will be placed under Modified GCQ.

TOURIST/NON-ESSENTIAL TRAVEL

Exemption: Visitors / Guests from Mandaue, Cebu City and Cebu Province

- Letter of Acceptance issued by the Lapu-Lapu City Government (if none, pax may apply upon arrival)
- Negative RT-PCR Test Result (72 hours prior departure) from DOH accredited laboratory
- In the event that the guest, visitor, or tourist does not have a RT-PCR test result upon arrival at the airport, they can undergo RT-PCR testing at their own expense. Thereafter, they shall isolate at their hotel until the results are released.
- Proof of confirmed booking in a hotel or accommodation establishment based in Lapu-Lapu City with a DOT Certificate of Authority to Operate
- Roundtrip ticket

LSI

- Letter of Acceptance issued by Lapu-Lapu City Government

APOR

- Letter of Acceptance issued by the Lapu-Lapu City Government
- Valid ID
- Certificate of employment which shall also state purpose of travel

APOR shall include the following:

- Health and emergency frontline services personnel,
- Government officials and government frontline personnel,
- Duly-authorized humanitarian assistance actors

- Persons travelling for medical or humanitarian reasons
- Persons transiting to the airport for travel abroad,
- Returning or repatriated OFWs and other OFWs returning to their places of residence
- Other persons transported through the efforts of the national government upon observance of the necessary quarantine protocols and with the concurrence of the receiving LGUs
- Uniformed personnel, government officials and employees for official business with corresponding travel authority
- Those transporting medical supplies and laboratory specimens related to COVID-19
- Anyone crossing zones for work permitted in the zone of destination and going back home
- Lawyers in the private practice, upon presentation of their Integrated Bar of the Philippines (IBP) ID

RETURNING OVERSEAS FILIPINOS (ROF), who arrived at the Ninoy Aquino International Airport and returning to their residence in Lapu-Lapu City via Mactan Cebu International Airport Domestic Terminal, shall be authorized to enter upon presentation of the following documents:

- a. Letter of Acceptance issued by the Lapu-Lapu City Government or barangay;
- b. Negative RT-PCR result;
- c. Bureau of Quarantine Certificate of Completion of Quarantine

The aforementioned requirements shall not apply to ROFs who arrived at Mactan Cebu International Airport – Domestic Terminal and whose residence is outside Lapu-Lapu City.

REMINDER: Provide an advance copy of the list of passengers bound for Lapu-Lapu City at arrivals.lapulapucity@gmail.com

CLARK (ANGELES CITY)

- **APOR**
 - Only the following persons shall be allowed entry into Angeles City:
 - APOR
 - Persons traveling on official business, provided that they are able to present written documentation as proof
 - Non-APOR individuals coming from outside the Province of Pampanga shall not be allowed entry into Angeles City
 - Residents of Angeles City who are working outside the Province of Pampanga are advised to stay in their place of employment for the duration of the community quarantine; should they prefer otherwise, they may be allowed to return to Angeles City, provided that they have tested negative for COVID-19 via RT-PCR testing prior to their return
- **LSIs**

- Arrival of the LSI has been duly coordinated with the City Government
- LSI has tested negative for COVID-19 through RT-PCR testing prior to their arrival
- Passengers of domestic flights arriving at the Clark International Airport should have tested negative for COVID-19 through RT-PCR testing before being allowed entry into Angeles City

COTABATO

LSI & ROF

- All persons entering Cotabato shall declare their purpose and present an ID containing their address
- Those who are not APOR and do not possess an ID with and address in Cotabato City shall be denied entry

APOR

- Certificate of Acceptance from City Government of Cotabato

DAVAO

- Authorized Persons Outside Residence and their requirements for entry to Davao City:
 - A. Health and Emergency Frontline Services personnel
 - B. Government officials, employees, government frontline personnel.
 - C. Duty-Authorized Humanitarian Assistant Actors (HAAs)
 - D. Coming in from work or business and going home;
 - Requirements:
 1. Via Air Travel
 - JTF Covid Shield:
 1. Company/Office ID and Certificate of Employment or Acknowledgement of Principal for Labor/service (for those without employer-employer relationship)
 - Local Government Unit
 2. Company/Office Travel Order
 3. Hotel and other similar accommodation establishments Confirmation (APOR cannot stay in the houses of Davao City residents)
 4. Round trip Ticket
 5. Twenty-four to forty-eight (24-48) hour RT-PCR test results or test upon arrival.
 - E. Persons traveling for medical, dental and allied medical reason with one (1) driver and one (1) assistant)
 - Requirements:
 1. Certification of travel to access health services from a doctor, dentist, hospital, medical or allied medical institution
 - F. Extraordinary Humanitarian Consideration or accessing National Government Agency/Office Service.
 - Requirements:

1. Travel Confirmation from Davao City Government. Recognition must be submitted at least five (5) days before the intended date of travel.
 2. The ID used to register for a Travel Confirmation Pass
- G. Persons residing outside Davao City going to Davao International Airport (DIA)
- Requirements:
 1. Confirmed Plane Ticket
- H. Bus, Van and Airplane passengers who arrive/land in Davao City but are travelers bound for another city/municipality/LGU
- Requirements:
 1. Twenty-four to seventy-two (24-72) hour from date of arrival negative RT-PCR test result or testing upon arrival
 2. Confirmation from destination LGU of pick-up vehicle, OR
 3. Confirmation of private/public transportation arrangement from airport or bus terminal to destination LGU
- I. Returning Davao City resident by land, air or sea, including the LSIs, OFs, OFWs
- Requirements:
 1. Twenty-four to seventy-two (24-72) hour from date of arrival negative RT-PCR test result or testing upon arrival, AND
- J. Returning Davao City resident frequently travelling by land for work
- Requirements:
 1. Company/Office Travel Order
 2. An ID with a Davao City address, OR any document with a Davao City address and ID
 3. A current month RT-PCR negative test result, if available.
- Non-APOR – All those not listed above in letters (A) to (K) are considered Non-Authorized Persons Outside of Residence.
- Requirements:
 1. Travel Confirmation from Davao City Government. Registration must be submitted at least five (5) days before the intended date of travel
 2. The ID used to register for a Travel Confirmation
 3. Hotels and other similar accommodation establishments confirmation (APOR cannot stay in the houses of Davao City residents)
- Davao QR Code (<https://hdform.davaocity.gov.ph/form>) - must be scanned and accomplished upon check-in at airport of origin
- Health Declaration Form for purposes of contact tracing
- Certification - Undertaking of 14-day quarantine (at LGU quarantine facility/home)
- **Negative RT-PCR test result taken within 24 to 72 hours from the date of departure not mandatory upon check-in at the airport of origin. However, arriving passengers with negative RT-PCR test results are prioritized for exit from the Davao International Airport (DIA) after checking their health declaration forms (HDFs)**
- Note: The free RT-PCR testing for arriving passengers at the Davao International Airport has been temporarily suspended starting from January 13.***
- A. Accept negative RT-PCR result taken within 24 to 72 hours from the domestic departure date conducted by a laboratory overseas for international flight passenger. All data therein must have an English translation for non-English speaking countries.**

B. Note that children 12 years old and below are exempted from the RT-PCR requirement upon check-in, provided that, the accompanying adult passenger presents a negative RT-PCR results taken within 24 to 72 hours from the date of departure

C. All those who are allowed to board for Davao-bound flights without RT-PCR testing must observe the following:

1. Non-Davao City passengers may still exit the airport even without the RT-PCR negative test result as long as their LGUs will fetch them and they can present other needed documents

2. For Davao City residents without negative RT-PCR test results to show, HDFs and other necessary documents will be checked.

- To ensure a safe and orderly exit out of the airport, passengers with Negative RT-PCR test results must be seated away from passengers who do not have RT-PCR test results
- Deplane all those with a negative RT-PCR test results first, followed by all those without their RT-PCR test result

D. All those who were tested in their place of origin within 24-72 hours of departure date but have not received their result shall not be allowed to exit the DIA until their test result is available

E. The negative RT-PCR result should be taken within 24 to 72 hours from departure date. If the result is more than 72 hours, we shall re-test the passenger in the DIA

- Issuance of Letter of Acceptance or Notice of Coordination for LSI, ROF, OFW, APOR traveling to Davao City will be dispensed and waived by the City Government.
- Certificate of Acceptance by the receiving LGU is not a requirement for LSI

 - Passenger must submit proof of Indispensable travel such as family emergency or medical emergency.
 - Provide complete personal information such as government full name, contact number, company, company contact name and number and the duration of stay in Ilocos Norte.

 - If conducted upon arrival, pax shall be placed under quarantine until release of negative result. If the RT-PCR test yields a negative result, pax shall be released and the validity shall be a period of **5 days**. Should pax to extend their stay, they shall be required to undergo testing, either RT-PCR or Antigen Test.
- 14-day quarantine at a government quarantine facility or an accredited private quarantine facility shall only be implemented for inbound travelers who develop symptoms anytime during his/her stay in the Province of Bohol and have tested positive for RT-PCR
- For those who availed of a repeat RT-PCR and yielded positive results, they shall be immediately isolated and quarantined for a period of 10 days at a government quarantine facility or an accredited private quarantine facility. If they have no symptoms for 3 consecutive days, they shall be discharged as clinically recovered.

TOURIST:

- Confirmed Hotel Booking – tourist need to have a confirmed booking with an accommodation establishment (AE) located in the Municipalities of Panglao or Dauis which has a Certificate of Authority to Operate (CAO) from the Department of Tourism (DOT) or the Ultimate Bohol Experience (UBE) Seal from the Provincial Government of Bohol.
- **Negative RT-PCR Test Result (72 hours validity) and Testing Protocols**
 - Only tourists who have obtained a negative RT-PCR test result from a DOH accredited Lab not earlier than seventy-two (72) hours prior to the date of travel, shall be allowed entry to the Province of Bohol.
 - Tourists who have cancelled bookings or last-minute changes in their flight schedules may also opt to be swabbed upon arrival in Bohol at their own expense. However, they would need to fill up a signed undertaking stating that they are willing to undergo strict hotel quarantine until their negative RT-PCR result is released.
 - Locals may join the meetings, incentives, conventions, and exhibitions (MICE) and events (wedding, reunions, anniversaries, birthdays, and similar celebrations), provided that after the said activity, they will agree to be quarantined for five (5) days and be swabbed for RT-PCR testing and that they will only be allowed to go home once a negative results of the said test is released.
- Visit to Tourism Sites – trips outside the AE may only be done thru DOT accredited travel and tour operators and only to sites which have the UBE Seal by the Provincial Government of Bohol. List of Tourism Service providers with DOT Accreditation and establishments granted by UBE Seal are posted at the Bohol Tourism website: tourism.bohol.gov.ph.
- Online Registration – Tourist must register through the Bohol Tourist Registration portal via tourism.bohol.gov.ph, registered tourists will be sent necessary information and instructions

through their respective emails. A personal QR code will be assigned to each registered tourist which would serve as their electronic visitor's ID. It is strictly mandated that there shall be no walk-in tourists.
